 **Dogs** -  Well-behaved **dogs are welcome**, but they must **stay on a lead at all times** due to **sheep and nearby game birds**.


 **Off-lead play** is only allowed in the **designated paddock** if your dog is used to sheep and won't escape under the gate or over the fence.


 **Adults-Only Site**-  No children under the age of 14.


 **Please keep noise levels down after 11 PM** and before **8 AM** to respect fellow caravaners.

 **Smoking is not allowed** in or near the **toilet facilities**.

 **No ball games** or activities that could damage **cars or caravans**.

 **Do not climb or lean on gates or fences** – some have **electric wires** to prevent animals from reaching through.

 The **owner is not responsible** for any **loss, damage, or injury** affecting holidaymakers, **personal possessions, cars, caravans, or contents**.

 **Gated Access** - If you need to access the **main gate between 9 PM and 9 AM**, please **let us know in advance**. Security beams **trigger an alarm in the house**.

🚿 Shower Facilities

- The shower in the **facilities cabin** is **coin-operated** and accepts **20p & £1 coins**. If you need change, just ask us!
- **Pricing & Timing:**
 - **20p = 1 minute** 🕒
 - **£1 = 5 minutes** 🕒 🕒 🕒 🕒 🕒
 - The timer **starts immediately** after inserting coins.
 - A **beep sounds when 1 minute remains**. If you need more time, add another coin before the water turns cold.
 - We recommend at least **60p for a more relaxing shower** 😊
- **Temperature is fixed** to prevent scalding. Instructions are posted near the shower.

💧 Waste Disposal

- 🗑️ **Grey Waste Water Point** – Located **to the left** of the cabin facilities.
- 🚰 **Chemical Waste/Elson Point** – Near the entrance to the **grass pitches**, on the **right**.

Map of the CL Site

The map below shows the pitch layout for the CL Site, South is in the direction of the dog paddock. We don't mind which way round you pitch your caravan/motorhome/campervan. If you have booked a hard standing pitch you are welcome to use a grass pitch if desired. If any pitches have a reserved sign, please look at the arrival dates. If you use either pitch 8 or 9 we recommend you face your caravan/motorhome towards the paddock for a better view, obviously this depends on which side your door is and if you are putting an awning up.



Walk to Skipwith Common or The Drovers

Arms

Please note that although most of this route is marked on OS Maps you will not see any footpath signs to direct you. We have therefore created maps of the route and directions for you to follow, they can be found in the cabin facilities (please ask if you can't find them).

We have been granted permission to walk along a track near our farm, this is a permissive path and the access can be withdrawn at any time. We also have permission to walk down the road to Manor House, the same rule applies so please pickup after your dogs and respect the Farmers, Landowners and Gamekeepers - thank you 😊

Note that Dogs must be kept on a lead due to ground nesting birds and the local Estate Shoot. There is also livestock in Skipwith Common including Hebridean sheep, Longhorn cattle along with Exmoor ponies.

Please note that during wet periods the route may be muddy in parts and it takes you to the Drovers Arms public house (Route 1) or to the beginning of Skipwith Common down Common Road (past some houses) (Route 2). The route may also be overgrown (so we recommend you wear trousers and suitable footwear) and please take some strong insect repellent at certain times of year.



Where to start

Please note that although most of this route is marked on OS Maps you will not see any footpath signs to direct you, so please take a copy of this map with you.

Follow the signs for the Short Walk (opposite the Rubbish & Recycling Area) until you get to the edge of our fields (there is a small Skipwith sign at the end of the trail). Turn left onto the track towards the main road and then cross the road onto the lane opposite. Follow the track until you almost reach the house at Manor Farm (don't go through any gates) and turn right, just before the holly bush. Continue along the track (shown as Broad Lane on the map) until you reach Bonby Lane (this track is used to access the Paintballers area so you may see a few cars). Go straight across the minor road to the small car park and you will find the path at the back to the right. Follow the map to get to the **Drovers Arms (Route 1)**, you will see a well trodden path on your right (note there has recently been some thinning of trees etc so this may have changed). Or you can continue on to **Route 2**, the only part you have to walk along the road is in the village, please be careful and walk on the village green as much as possible.

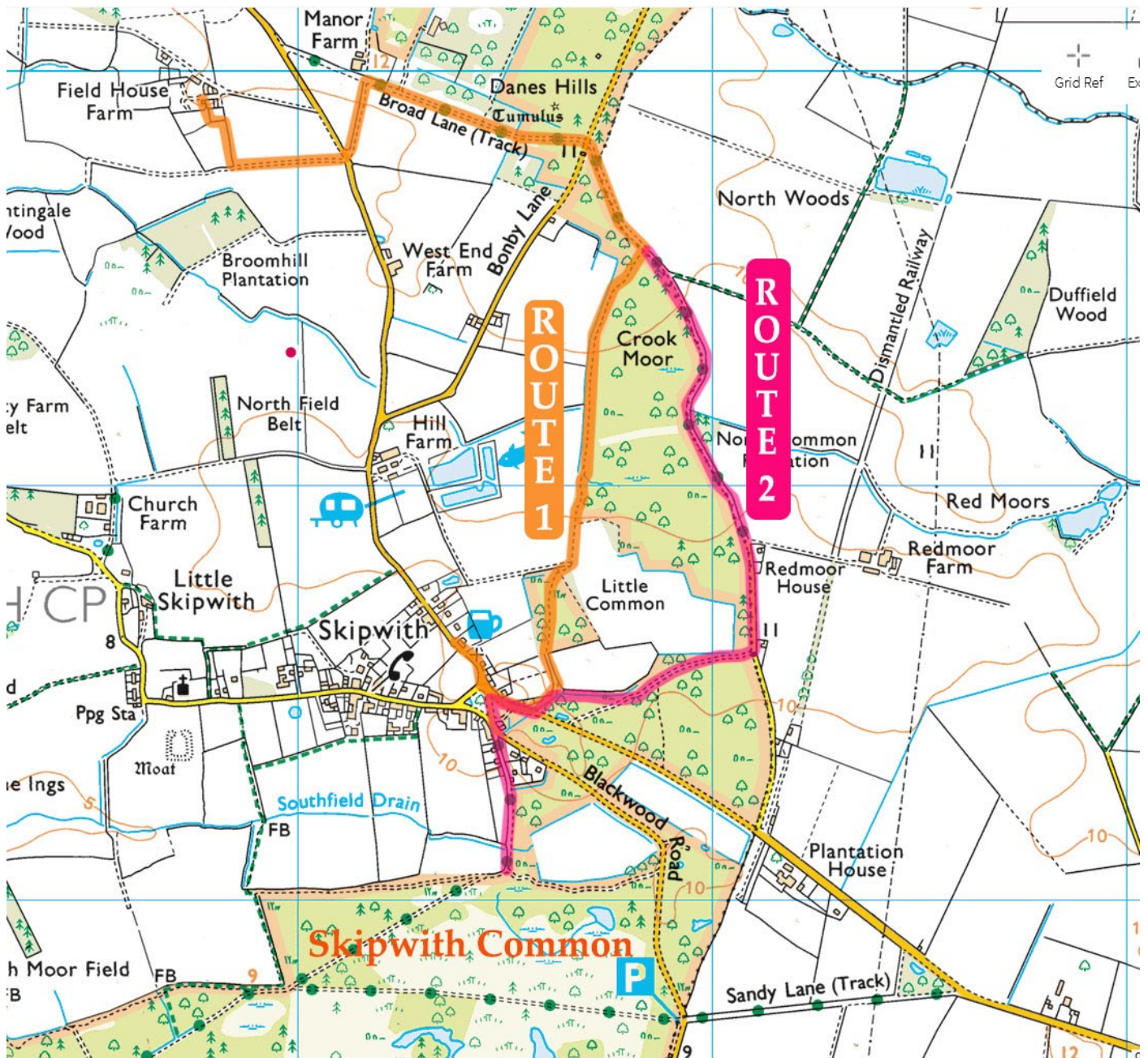
We don't recommend walking along the main road from our farm to Skipwith due to the speed of traffic.

Route 1 Walk to the Drovers Arms:

- Approximately 40 minutes each way
- 2.97 km

Route 2 – longer route to get to Skipwith Common:

- Approximately 50 minutes each way
- 3.7km

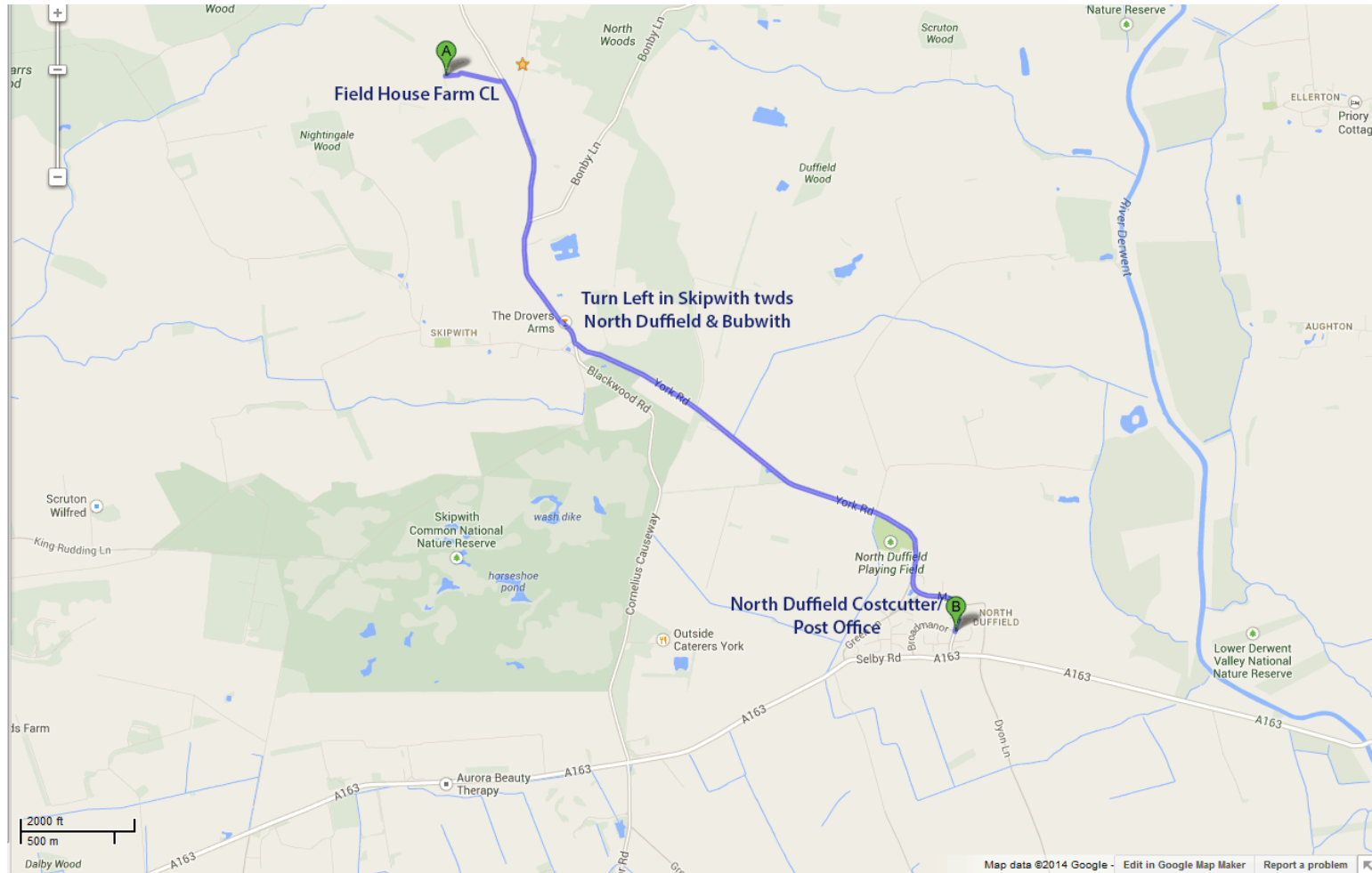

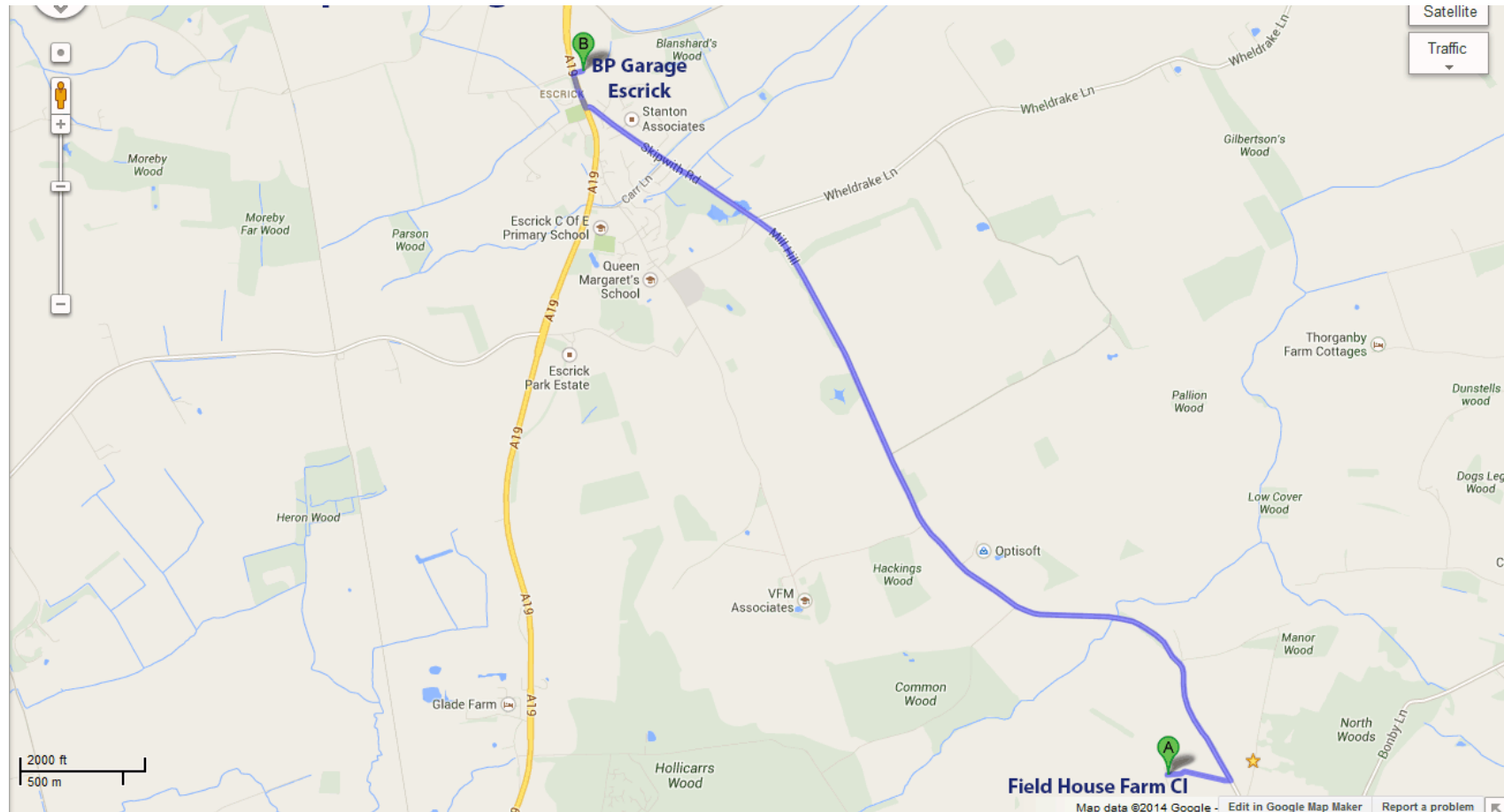

Map showing route to the nearest local shop in North Duffield (now McColl's)

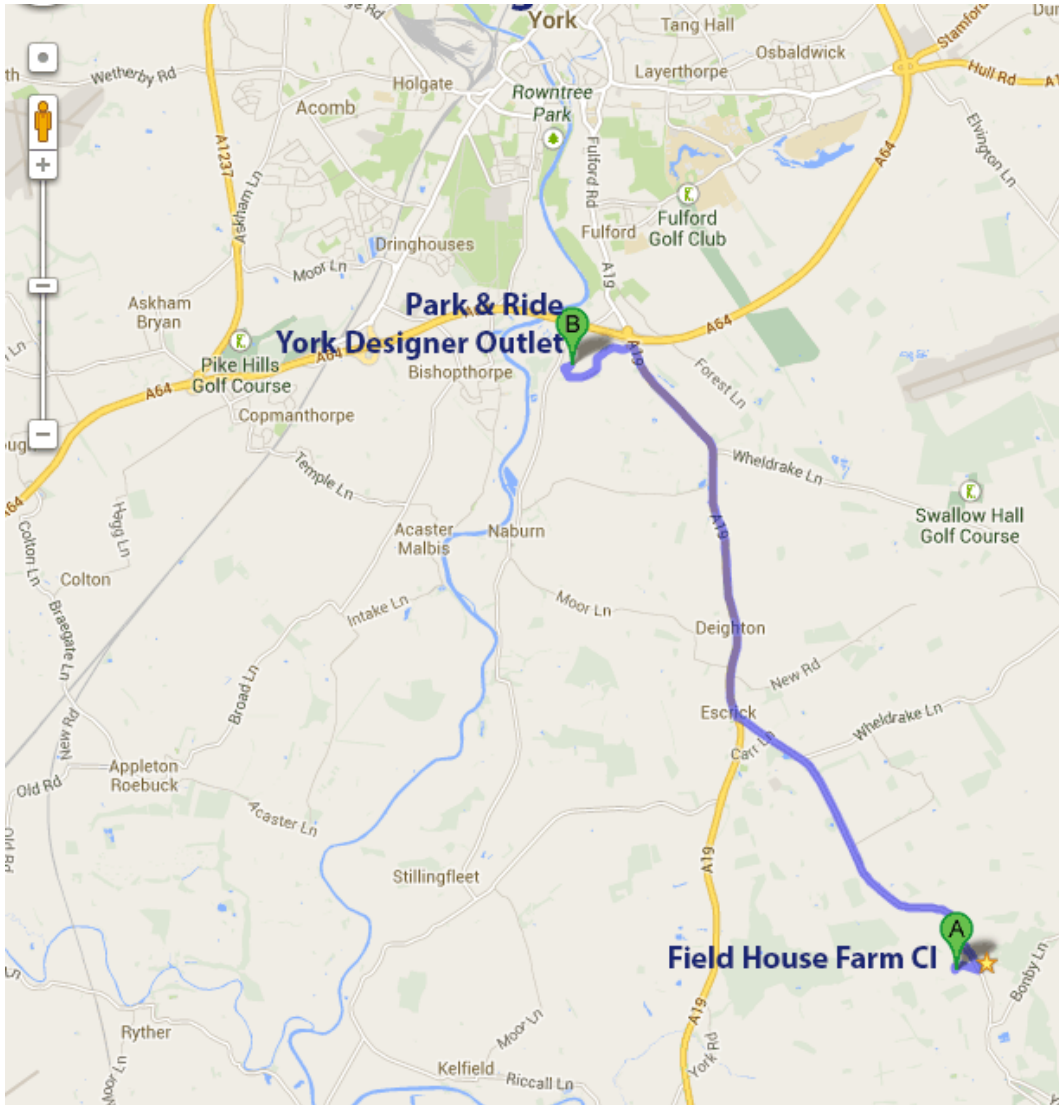


Map showing nearest Petrol Station & Shop at Escrick



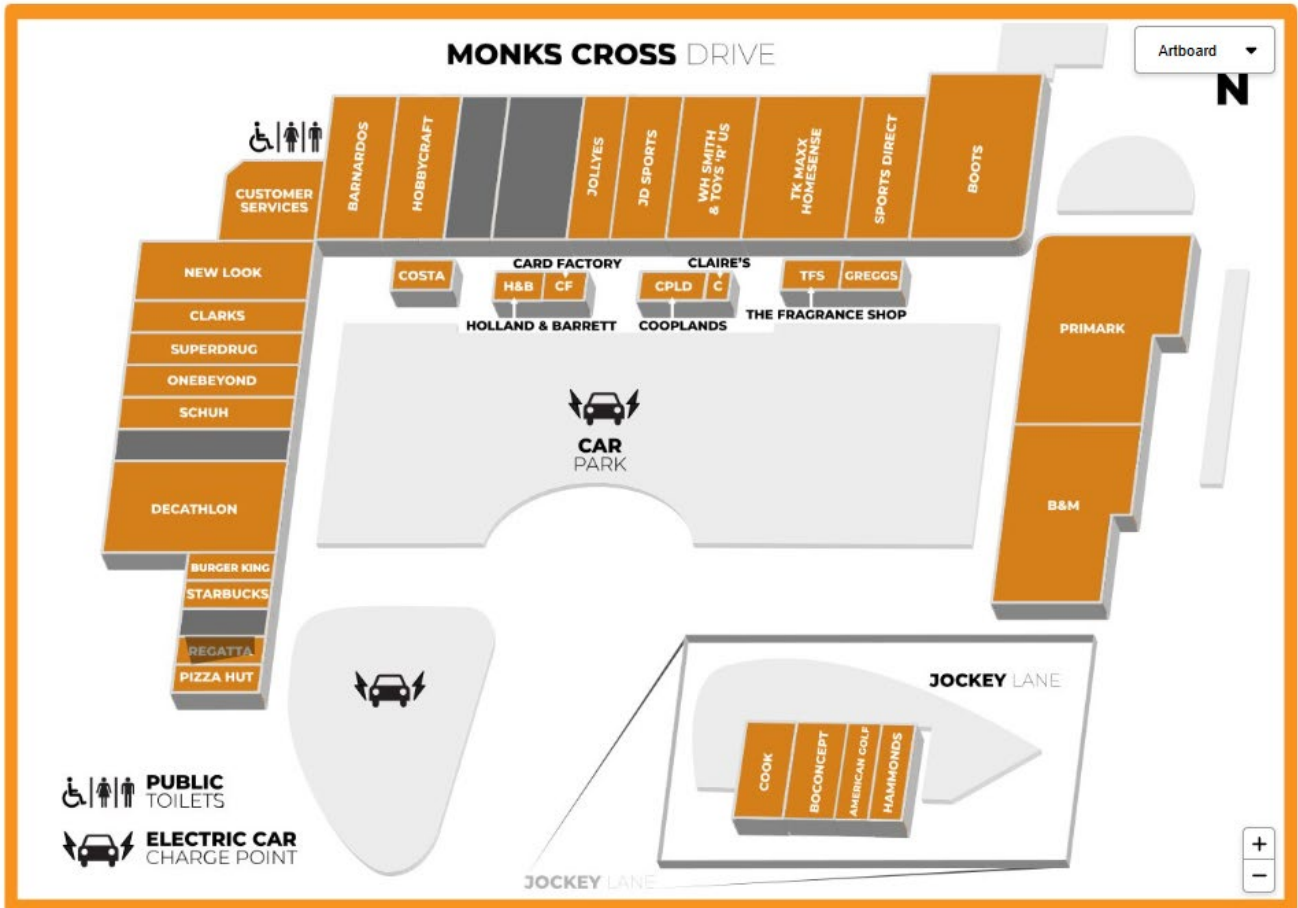

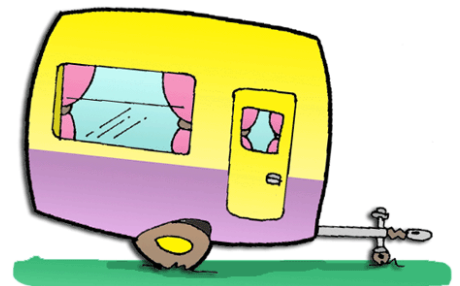

Be Mindful of Electricity Use



We have a **limited power supply**, and upgrading would cost at least **£26,000**. To avoid reducing hook-ups from **16A to 10A**, please try to minimize the use of high-power appliances:

-  **Instead of electric kettles, please use gas kettles**  
-  **Avoid slow cookers, steamers, George Foreman grills, etc.** – they use a lot of power over time
-  **Use smaller hairdryers, travel irons, or gas alternatives**
